

HALVORSON

Mr. Gordon Halvorson, of Sylvan Lake, passed away at the Red Deer Regional Hospital, on February 13, 1995 at the age of 79 years. Born at Strongfield, Saskatchewan, on January 4, 1916. He came to the Burnt Lake area with his parents in April, 1919, to a ready built granary, with a new home being built before winter. He worked in the lumber camps around Rocky; with Assiniboine Construction in Penhold and Calgary. He purchased a quarter section of land in the Burnt Lake area on which he broke land and farmed until he retired to Sylvan Lake on November 15, 1973. Gordon is survived by two sisters, Alice Engman, of Red Deer, Florence Sauer, of Athabasca; three brothers, Howard Halvorson and his wife Aneta, of Red Deer, Arthur Halvorson and his wife Grace, of Eckville and Clifford Halvorson and his wife Daisy, of Sylvan Lake; and special friend, Frieda Place; as well a numerous nieces, nephews, grand-nieces and grand-nephews. He is predeceased by his father, Andrew, in 1962 and his mother, Lydia, in 1982. Funeral Services for the late Mr. Gordon Halvorson will be held from The Memorial Presbyterian Church, Sylvan Lake, on Friday, February 17, 1995 at 2:00 p.m. with Reverend Rod Ferguson officiating.
