GROWER CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into in triplicate this 1 day of May, 1961,
by and between the MONTANA MUSTARD SEED COMPANY of Power, Montana, party of the first part, here-
inafter to be called "Buyer," and PETER TASTAD

of STRONGFIELD, County of _____, State or Province SASK.
party of the second part, hereinafter called "Grower."

PLEASE PRINT

WITNESSETH:

That said land is leased and rented from _____
who is to receive for the 19____ rental of said land, an undivided _____ share of said crop as
rental for said year.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Grower, for and in consideration of, the hereinafter contained covenants and agreements, agrees
to plant and harvest mustard seed for the Buyer during the growing season of 1961 on 150
acres of the above described premises; said land to be summer fallow, and reasonably free from foul weeds.

2. It is further agreed that the Grower will sow no mustard in addition to the acreage
named above for himself or any other party whomsoever in 1961. Should additional acreage be grown by him,
this contract shall, at the option of the Buyer, become subject to immediate cancellation, or require delivery of the
entire crop grown, including all additional acreage.

3. It is further agreed by the Grower that he will deliver the entire crop of aforementioned seed grown on said
land to the Buyer, at such time or times as the Buyer shall designate from the date such crop is harvested until and
not later than March 31, 1962.

4. It is further agreed by the Grower, that the said mustard crop so delivered
shall be in bulk, dry and in good condition, and shall be hauled by truck to the Buyer F.O.B. warehouse,
Federal Grain Co. Strongfield.

5. It is further agreed by the Buyer, that upon delivery of said crop of SEED by the Grower, the said Buyer
will carefully clean and remove from said SEED, all screenings and foreign matter which can be reasonably re-
moved with their cleaning equipment; said screenings, foul and foreign matter, to belong to the Buyer.

6. It is further agreed by the Buyer, that they will pay to the Grower forthwith in the manner in this para-
graph provided for and on account of said mustard seed the full sum of \$ 2.50 per
hundred pounds, net weight, for all mature, clean, dry and sound mustard seed so delivered by the
Grower; that is to say, the Buyer to pay the Grower for Dockage free Number One seed only.

Dockage to be determined by the Board of Grain Commissioners.

7. It is mutually agreed that time is as of the essence of this agreement, and that all covenants and agreements
herein contained, shall extend to and be obligatory upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the re-
spective parties herein.
