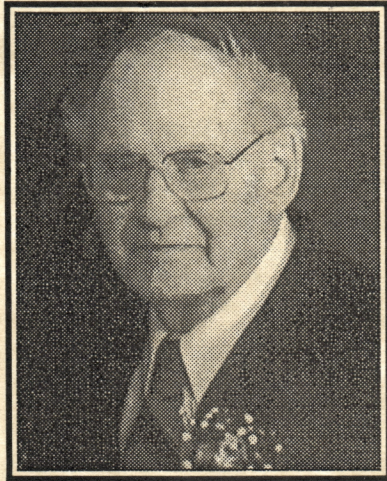

The passing of John Edward Stronski of Loreburn, Sask. occurred on Thursday, May 12, 1994 at Royal University Hospital in Saskatoon at the age of 69 years. John was born in Kincaid, Sask. on November 4, 1924 to Peter and Mary Stronski. At age 4 he arrived in Loreburn with his parents and took his schooling there. At age 17 he went to Toronto, Ont. to work for the B/A Oil Refinery. In 1942 John joined the Navy and served on the Atlantic and North Seas during the 2nd World War. After the war he came back to Loreburn to try his hand at farming. He met and married June McLean in 1947. He then worked for the Interprovincial Pipeline until 1958 when he went into business for himself and opened an auto dealership and service station. He retired in 1989 leaving a successful business to his sons. John was very community minded; he served on town council, was mayor, was charter member of the Lions Club, a member of the Loreburn Legion, and a supporting member of the Loreburn United Church. He liked sports, especially hockey and curling and in later years, golf. John and June enjoyed many winters travelling and also spent a few winters in Mesa, Arizona. Through his business, sports, community functions and travels, he met and made many friends whom he cherished over the years. John never forgot a face.
