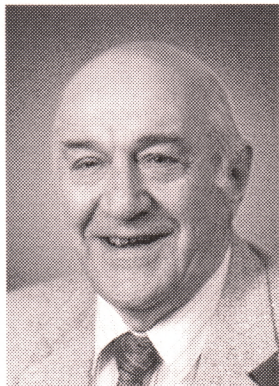

Rev. Oscar James Johnson, one of 11 children was born to John and Lilly Johnson on February 23rd, 1916 on the family farm at Hanley, SK. He farmed as his first life's work, and then ministered in the Lutheran Church for more than 40 years. He died peacefully on Wednesday July 17th, 1996. In 1933 he left High School to help farm. At the untimely death of his father, he and his brother Harry, took over the family farm. In 1948, Oscar accepted the call to ministry in the church. He enrolled at the Lutheran Theological Seminary and completed his training in 1953. Oscar began ministering in Edmonton, AB and then completed pastorates in Erickson, MB, Binford and Harvey, North Dakota, and Melville, SK, retiring from parish ministry in 1981. He then served as a chaplain for the Lutheran Care Society in Saskatoon from 1981-1985 initiating that ministry to hospitalized people. Oscar will be remembered for his love and understanding of people, his caring way and gentle humor, and his sense of God's awesome nature and love.

Oscar was predeceased by his parents, his first wife Beulah, his sister Hazel Hay and sister-in-law Clara Johnson.
