General Information

PASSPORTS: U. S. Citizens must be in possession of a valid passport, obtainable from U. S. Passport Bureau, Department of State, Washington, D. C. or through nearest Federal, District, or County Court.

Applicants residing in or near New York, Boston, Chicago, Seattle, San Francisco or New Orleans may apply to U. S. Passport Agency in cities mentioned. U. S. Passport Agencies in New York are located at: Sub-Treasury Building, Pine and Nassau Streets and at 630 Fifth Avenue, Rockefeller Center. Application should be made in ample time before sailing.

VISAE: Visae are required for most European countries. Inquire at nearest N.A.L. office or General Agent as to latest visa requirements.

RESIDENT ALIENS: Resident aliens of the United States should be in possession of a valid passport issued by the nearest consulate representing their native country. Visae are required in many instances. Consult nearest N.A.L. office or General Agent for latest particulars regarding visae.

REENTRY PERMITS: Resident aliens, legally admitted to the United States, and going abroad for a temporary visit, should, before departure, obtain an official permit to return to the United States. Application for such permit should be filed with the Commissioner of Immigration and Naturalization approximately 30 days before date of departure. Application forms obtainable from nearest N.A.L. office or General Agent.

SAILING PERMITS: Alien passengers should obtain from the nearest local Income Tax Collector a Certificate of Compliance (Form 1040C). In New York City such forms are obtainable at the Office of Internal Revenue, Alien Tax Division, 17 East 42nd Street, Room 400, New York, N. Y. It is necessary to bring passport and passage ticket when calling for Sailing Permit.

BAGGAGE: Cabin class passengers are allowed 20 cubic feet of baggage free of charge; tourist and third class passengers are allowed 15 cubic feet of baggage free of charge. Excess baggage will be charged for at \$1.00 per cubic foot. Only passenger's personal baggage is considered and charged for as baggage. All baggage, except stateroom baggage, should be checked with Baggage Master on pier before boarding steamer, and checks obtained for same.
