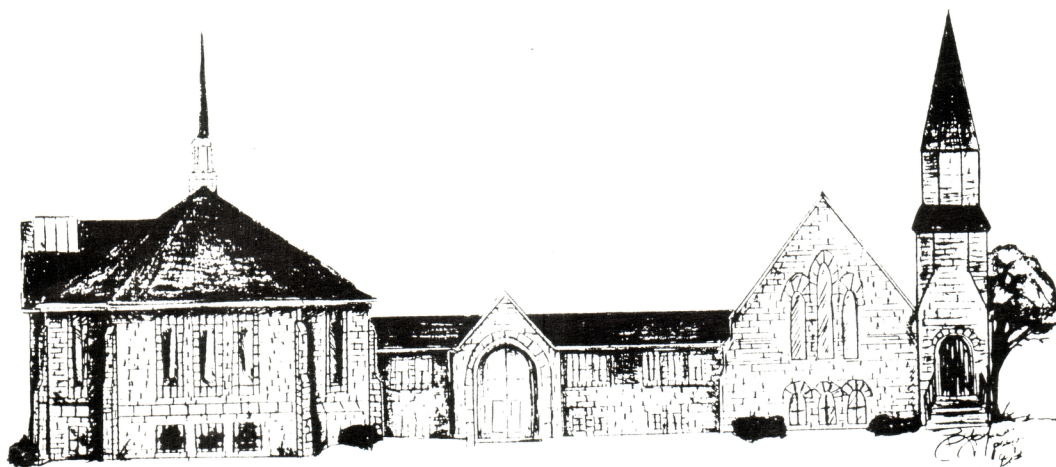

In 1985, the Session and Board of St. Andrew's met to share concerns about the adequacy of parking and church school space. A committee of Session investigated the possibilities of expansion of parking facilities, looked carefully at the usage of the Christian Education building, proposed to the Session that a second worship service be established.

When the expanded use of the facilities increased the problems of parking and the use of the Church School facilities, the Committee did more study and then proposed to the Session and proposed to the Congregation that new facilities should be explored. The Congregation concurred and through several successive meetings directed the Session and its Committee to direct its attention to expanding the building on this site.

The architectural firm of Brown, Beck & Ross was requested to prepare drawings. Chapelstone Developments was approached to manage the construction. Presbyterian Church Building Corporation and The Royal Bank were requested to handle the financial aspects. The Presbytery of East Toronto was asked to approve the building and financial arrangements.

On June 30, 1991, the congregation broke the sod for the new construction. The construction began in September, 1991. The congregation began worshipping in the new space on Easter Sunday, April 19, 1992, even though all the work was not completed. On this day, June 14, 1992, we celebrate the completion of our new building, and we dedicate these new facilities to the Glory of God.
