I GIVE, DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my daughter, JENNIE PERKINGSTAD, the South-west quarter of section Thirty-three (33) in township Twenty-six (26) in range Five (5) West of the Third Meridian, in the province of Saskatchewan.

THE RESIDUE of my estate, both real and personal, not hereinbefore disposed of, I GIVE, DEVISE AND BEQUEATH unto my beloved wife, HANNAH C. TASTAD, for her own use absolutely.
