Mr. Tastad.

I explained to Mr. Tastad while he was in hospital the findings of the x-rays and that we did not find anything that the radiologist thought was cancer. However, there is some chronic inflammation in the lining of the stomach and he has also a diverticulum (out-pouching with a sac) from the second part of the duodenum which is part of the small bowel. Otherwise the x-rays were fairly normal.

I am enclosing a diet called "Gastric Diet #3", marked by the ink line on pages 1 and 2, which I will send as a guide for Mr. Tastad's diet.

I would like to repeat the x-rays again in about three months' time or sooner if he is having trouble.
