

Trip to Norway 1989  
May 29 - July 3

Wells contact arrived shortly  
after 6 a.m. - the reverse our trip  
& left for the airport. It was a  
beautiful calm, sunny day.  
Checked our bags, etc. with  
'Canadian' and went to the  
Cafe for toast & coffee.  
Went then directly to the  
restaurant in the plane (at side)  
& were off at 9:30 a.m. in the  
plane. There we met Sue &  
Jordan. Had a nice wait  
for us and then a drink.  
It was so nice to have them  
& to know we knew each  
other. It's after 2 in Calgary.  
We had coffee here with them.  
Sue & Jordan had an outfit  
about 11 a.m. so had to leave just  
but then stayed until about 12.

We expected to board the plane before 2, but the plane from Vancouver was over booked - many were paid to re-book to make room for those who needed to go that day. It was for that reason our flight was delayed more than 4 hours, so we missed connections at Amsterdam. We phoned Ingebet from Amsterdam so he met us much later than first planned.

D.C. 10 When we boarded the plane at Calgary we found another couple in our seat (it was double booked!) We had to wait in another part while the stewards & stewardesses got things righted. I believe that couple had to leave the plane & re-book. Anyhow we got our seat, and finally we were on our way. The plane was completely filled and there wasn't much room to spare. Walter was able to get one leg out in the aisle.

We were served lots of meals and lots of hot or cold drinks on

the way, so there was no chance to get uneasy or bored, and no chance to sleep either!

~~Earlier~~ We met a nice group at the airport in Calgary. A mother, daughter & son were returning to Stavanger after visiting their son (& wife) who is taking helicopter flying there. A lovely group. We were with them both in Amsterdam & Stavanger airports too. They live on a small island between here & Karmsøy.

We have it so nice at Skurtveits. They have a large 2-storey home & live upstairs. Down on the main floor are 2 bedrooms (one for each of us) bath rooms & a large hall & stairway - so we sort of have our own suite! The upstairs is furnished beautifully, and we've had delicious meals. The first meal Tues eve. - was a pork roast with all the trimmings. In the eve. we went for a long drive - to Tasta was sad to see. The buildings were burned down the day of Sofie's funeral.

We slept in Wed. a. m. and then Walter & I went for a long walk. We found Missionsveien and Karen & Salles' horse. It was wonderful to see them. She is still so pretty & was dressed nice even tho' we weren't expected. She didn't even know we were in Norway. She remembered so much of her Canada trip - which she has lived over & over again. She has had surgery (it seemed it could have been thyroid) & said she wasn't the same after that - has become forgetful. He is very sharp tho'. We are invited there for 5 pm on Sat to meet her family.

Then we walked back - got ~~at~~ some traveller cheques cashed & bought some oranges, & some flourishes for Inger & Mame.

Then we came back here. For supper we had soup, & boiled cod (slightly salted) It was delicious!

In the eve. we drove out to Baardssons. Walter phoned them & talked to both of them.

Ingebrigt took us there & Le & Marie came at 10:30 to meet them and to pick us up. A full day!!

Thurs. - after we had breakfast we decided to go by bus down town. It rained so we had to use umbrellas. Marie was with us. We picked up some post cards, and some decorations for Kruse Kake - for Folkfest.

Then we met Dagfinn Halund at the Dom kirke (this was planned) We had planned to take them to a cafe for coffee, but instead they took us to their place & we had a wonderful time. They took us to all the schools (Faste) & I got pictures - this is one thing I didn't get to do in 1968 but it worked out today and I am so glad for that. We are to go there again when Garth & Kristen come.

We also went to a Bookstore & ordered (& paid for) the books Irene ordered - so that is done.

Dagfinn drove us home & now we are just relaxing here before we have another bite of supper.

Friday - I washed a few clothes - shorts & socks for Walter & filled the machine with bath towels. Ingebet was away all day <sup>(hours)</sup> on an outing with church stuff, and Marie went to receive a gift certificate for - years with her nursing with the city. Walter & I walked to the church where Inge works - ~~Inge~~ made a hair appt for me with a hairdresser who works at the church - gives shampoos, sets or perms for seniors for about 1/2 regular price. It took about an hour & cost 70 Kroner.

We walked back "home" and stopped at the store near here - interesting to see their lovely fish & meat displays, Komla, warm fish cakes, thin pancakes with a strip of bacon fried in it etc. Walter wants to take some video pictures there - to show the good fish, prices, etc.

Sat - We got dressed up & walked to Karens for supper at 5. Brought her some flowers - she had two trays of fancy open faced sandwiches and blötkäke for dessert. It was so very nice to be there & meet Kaare & his wife (works in Rogaland bank)

and <sup>Karen's</sup> daughter Anne Grete (she reminds me of princess Anne.) We took video pictures here & had a good visit.

Kare & wife took us home here, and said they'd like to have us (& Karen) to their place after we come back from Skudenes. We really <sup>all</sup> liked them.

Friday evening ~~we~~ <sup>Eldbjørg</sup> & Einar came for us at 5 pm & took us to the Scandic hotel for supper. It's an expensive place - very nice. We had baked salmon with vegetables baked with it - <sup>all</sup> in tin foil. It was delicious!! We had Caramel pudding (sliced, & on a plate) for dessert - & so much coffee!

Then they took us to their place & we had a nice quiet time just talking & visiting. She played & he sang for us.

Then she absolutely wanted ~~us~~ to serve us coffee on her coffee table - also a fancy dessert (like a large jelly roll with lots of whipped cream) It was late when we got home.

They were taking her Mom with them next morning to Karmøy for weekend. - staying at a new hotel at Koppervik.

Sat. morning - all 6 of us went (in 2 cars) downtown - did some sight seeing at a large new building, "Arkarden". Walter bought lunch ("risengrön gröd" + some waffles). Walked around quite a bit down town before coming back home.

Sunday - Had a nice breakfast (even boiled eggs in egg cups) + walked to church (where Inge works) It took  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour. <sup>Pastor</sup> He spoke my nose so I didn't get it all. There was communion too. They served tea, coffee + juice outside after service. Then we walked home again. A beautiful sunny day ( $18^{\circ}\text{C}$ ) with no wind. Albert + Charlotte came here for dinner which was served on their patio outside - cold meats, tomatoes, cucumbers etc bread, jam etc, cake.

Then about 3 o'clock we went for a long drive - to Årdal, Bryne, Jäven - + drove back by the coast. Had supper at Tananger in a nice restaurant. (Walter pd).

Talked to Torgeir Ueland ~~of~~ this eve. - also Hendaal. Walter has appt with Hendaal Mon at 11:45 a.m. at Hella church. We'll try to meet Ueland's after we've been på karnias.

Mon. Walter, Marie & I were home alone in forenoon. Walked over to the store - took pictures (& video) of there. Marie bought fish ( ) which we had for supper - fried, with onions & baked potatoes. Had lunch before Ingeborg came home to take Walter down town - to Kelland's Church to meet with Martha Larsen etc.

I washed some clothes & we hung them on a line over the patio. It was a nice day so Marie & I sat on lawn chairs outside. She has a nice yard - lots of flowers.

I did some handwork on my "Grandpa's farm." Enjoyed the fish supper. Walter was tired when he came home. He had visited Karen again while Knadal had a nap. Then they went to a farm

Harristadi They have been mowing the grass on the tomt. She & Marie have been friends all down the years. Nice people.

Phoned Jennie - seemed to be a poor connection. Heard Anne Berstad died. Also phoned Magnus J. - we plan to go to Sk.havn Wed. ~~at~~ 4 pm ferry.

Three. Nandaal phoned. He will pick us up at the store at 12:15 today.

Then I walked in the room  
(had an umbrella) to the store  
and Nandaal came about on time.  
I drove to their place where I saw  
Nandaal served open sandwiches &  
potato cakes & dinner party. Also  
a nutted cake (like pley noll) made  
with margy from a chocolate  
dame — was there and after  
kenneth we 4 (Dawn stayed home)  
left in Darnell's Opel car on our  
trip to the mountains. We drove  
past Sanderson, Bryner, all of them  
— with a heavy downpour all  
the way. I was hoping we'd get above  
the clouds, but we didn't get that high.

Wed. We got packed for our trip to Karmøy.  
Left our "purchases" at Skurtveit as  
we'll be back to meet Garth & Kristin.  
Johanna phoned & said it would be  
better for us to come on the 4 p.m. ferry  
(instead of 1:40) as Princess Sonja would  
be at Skudenenes at 3, and all streets  
would be blocked until we'd come later.  
Ingebrut took us to the ferry & we had  
a good trip across. The sea was calm,  
and we visited with a young man  
who goes back & forth to Stavanger daily.  
He's in the military (navy) for 7 yrs  
& lives in Raugesund area. He  
helped us with our baggage in Haon.  
Magnus, Asleng, Anne Marie met  
us & took us to Johanna's - Anna also  
there, & Astrid. I set my bag on a  
chair & looked up right into Mom's  
eyes - her picture was on the piano  
& faced the door. After supper &  
a good visit I went with Magnus, Asleng  
& Walter to their place - phoned Jennie &  
Mary Knop - took a while to get there.  
(Asked for addresses of the families)  
Then Magnus drove us all round  
Sjy & Haon - so many new & large  
houses! and the trees have grown so much.  
Weather nice - but it feels cold.

Anna came over after breakfast - also Walter - he got  
a ride in with Aisling, all of us walked down town -  
many changes there. We bought 2 bouquets of flowers for  
John & Anna - flowers shop in what used to be bank, & Johannes also  
there. Cloudy & completely overcast all day  
and it rained again. No sun,  
and I felt cold all day - in house too.  
Walter came over & we had  
coffee, bread, cheese, cookies etc  
in living room. For ~~supper~~ <sup>midday</sup> (3:30)  
we had potatoes, cauliflower, carrots  
(from Israel?) & home made fiske pudding  
in a casserole with a lovely white  
sauce. Then we had blueberries  
& whipped cream. Magnus J came  
for Walter while we were still  
at the table. They were going to  
see about a car for Walter.  
Walter came back about 3:30 with a  
silver 4-door ford car. We<sup>4</sup> left after  
4 for Koppervik for a concert in the  
school auditorium. It was great!  
Everyone sat around tables - there were  
paper plates with 2 open-faced sandwiches,  
yellow cheese on bread & 2 waffles - all  
covered with saran wrap. A lady opened the  
service with a devotional, & everyone  
sang several verses of  
Then it was turned over to the leader of a  
"blanda kor" - they also sat around tables  
on a platform (not high). It was so informal  
like - soloists came to the mike, & the group  
would sing along. The lady director was  
dressed in white slacks with a red/white

casual pullover - but she made everyone want to sing. Many were familiar melodies, but not all. They were accompanied by a flute, accordion, 2 guitars, & a piano - but it was soft & beautiful.

- We had complimentary tickets for this! Then the leader said - "ska ve ha kaffe ná?" - so there was an intermission

All the singers got up & served everyone coffee - it was such a happy group.

Before the program began a lady came to greet us at our table - it was Wenche! She had seen us when we came in. (We haven't seen Aines & Magnus yet).

The last half of the concert was very good - Walter got most of it on video - until he ran out of film. After the

concert they presented flowers to some - among them was a lady who was 102! They helped her up the steps & interviewed her. She spoke well.

We also met 2 of Alitta's daughters there & were introduced to others (one was a niece of Louki's (Karen's), so was <sup>related</sup> on that side.

We went to the car but were blocked in for a while. Saw a man ~~at~~ distance - recognized him as Chris G. - Walter went to talk to him, but he was about to leave - got a ride with someone - so I haven't talked to him. Now that we have a car, we plan to take 2 days next wk. out that way.

When we got back here we walked up to Arne's house - busy doing some cement work on an outside wood-burning barbeque. Met Uta briefly, & youngest son of Jacob Con and his wife. He works in Stavanger during the week. - A young couple.

Sat. I got up after 7 - had a shower & shampoo. Hope my hair will be OK. Walter came before breakfast (9:45) and had coffee with us. Finished up around 10 & went down town - parked <sup>the car</sup> <sup>the car</sup> & walked down some of these narrow streets. Gunnar's bakken, søra gate - took pictures of Starnveien - boat from Stavanger that came in slowly & turned in to the pier. Met Agnes Ness - they had "gjester" from south Norway and had frokost at the new cafe that just opened this morning. So we went there too & had lunch. Three men entertained us - one played trekkspel, & one (the local Dr) played guitar, the third sang. We learned later that the singer was son of Magne Dale & was a teacher here. He was to play the organ <sup>for church</sup> on Sunday. We spent 2-3 hrs down town, & after getting groceries, went home & had ~~lunch~~ <sup>lunch</sup> ~~supper~~ - (1:30-2:00)

It was a beautiful, sunny day & the warmest so far (Magnus of said - first day of summer). We just stayed home this afternoon - on the deck, etc. Johanna. Astrid made rice for midday - good! (They have it always on Sat.)  
~~After~~ Later we went to the church to see the graves. Astrid brought white & blue lilacs & put on the graves - all were so well tended & had fresh flowers. Took pictures.

Then we went to Sjøe & had a lovely visit with Magnus & Aslaug. Got her Loebum recipe book - Astrid wants me to make pie one day, & apple dumplings. - Hazene drees - are so lush & green, & beautiful flowers. So many rhododendrons - different colors! Aslaug had a Clematis. The yard here at Johanna's Arnes is a real dream - so nicely manicured & landscaped - lawn, flower beds, rocks etc.

It was late when Walter took us home. I got ready for bed, but Johanna came to my room & said I had to sit with them & talk for awhile in L. Coorn!

Sun. I stayed in bed until 9 - & got ready for breakfast - am completely spoiled! We cleared the table & sat & watched a church service at 11 a.m. from Lade Kirke - an old church near Trondhjem. It was their 800<sup>th</sup> yr. jubileum - a good service - <sup>clear</sup> easy to understand. The king was there too for this special day.

The singing was also good - with trumpets & other instruments <sup>accompaniment</sup>. We are now on the deck - the sun feels good & warm (its cold inside)

Walter is coming for us after 1 - & we're going to the new Akra Surke for a special service & concert, & then going out for dinner.

Walter will come for us 3, and Aslaug will take her sister & Anna, so we'll be 7. (So glad for good weather.) Being we had reservations for this Johanna thought we'd not go to church, but had such a good service on TV.

We plan to spend Mon & Tues out at Akra, Ferdingsstad etc. Agnes & Magnus have invited all of us for Wed. and Anna is taking us out to the Cafe where they serve Komla on Thurs. So I'm not on a strict diet.

Later - ~~The~~ Aslaug, Reidun (her sister) & Anna led the way to Akra - we parked at a large building - an art display; and on the other part was a weaving display - beautiful things. How Florence would have enjoyed that. Then we drove to a restaurant - it was upstairs. Anna treated us (7) to a big turkey dinner. Large ~~big~~ <sup>size</sup> evening.

Then we walked to the new church  
We arrived early so ~~we~~ Aslaug  
showed us around. A daughter of a  
friend of hers had woven 3 pieces -  
one for Gethsemane, one for Easter & one for  
of Ascension. It was beautiful.

Walter took video of the concert. It  
was hard to hold the camera steady  
for so long - should have had the stand.  
I hope it will be a good recording  
and we can play it often.

When we came back here Walter  
<sup>here</sup> phoned Anna. She is 90 now, but  
asked us for 2 pm tomorrow (Mon)  
He went back to Lye & we 3 watched  
TV for a while. A symphony played  
at Holmentollen - people were  
seated on both sides - thousands!

Mon. - I'm waiting to get in to the bath  
room - Walter is picking us up to  
go down to the bank (for money)  
I need more films too.

at the bank <sup>(Loyalands)</sup> we met Jan <sup>Dalby</sup>  
- nephew of Lars - he works there.

The girl who waited on us was a friend  
of Anne Marie (M. & Aslaug's oldest girl) who  
remembered Walter from 12 years ago.

Then I bought 4 films - from Berdun  
- sister of Aslaug - who we were with  
us on Sun. to the concert at the church.

Johanna bought some mackeril & bread, etc. We washed clothes - undies, & Walter's shirts - on 5  
Went to Magnus & Aslang at 4:30  
Beautiful weather everyday.  
Had dried fish, fried salt pork, & dried peas (everything was delicious!)  
We had rhubarb & cut up prunes for dessert. Later we had coffee cream <sup>with Kiwi's</sup> cake, kofse, carrot cake fruit cake - so much good food!  
It was Johanna, Astrid, Walter & I Anna. Reidun, husband & daughter, Elin & wee daughter also (from way up north) came to meet us. Elin is leaving for home on thurs.  
We had such a lovely time there.

Tues. - Walter came for dinner - we had mackeril, fried with cream poured over it. Yummy!  
- Gun salad - with cream dressing. and a fruit soup (goose berries, & some apples in a sweet sauce. Very good served with fried mackeril. For coffee Johanna baked fresh waffles - I got her recipe - & we ate on her deck. The weather has been exceptionally nice & warm (22°C) every day.

Aslang phoned us to come out to John's (6 or 6:30) so we

got to see Johns cozy place - took pictures & video. Sat around his coffee table - Aslang brought carrot cake, lefse etc. It was so nice to be there. He has a very nice home there right beside Lyré plast - & we stayed until almost dark. Walter drove again round "Erik's by" - what lovely homes there, & beautiful views!

Wed. - Walter came at 11:30 today. (We were dressed up as we're to be at Magnus & ~~Agnes~~ Agnes at 2). We inquired about a Spark - found one downtown, & will decide after we find out about shipping, or bringing it home. Then we went to Melhus Møbler foraging - beautiful furniture - a lot of leather (soft & comfortable) (Saw several chairs good for Walter.) We want to take Lärth there next wk. Then we went to the museum. Didn't have time to see everything as it was almost 2 - but will go again. How nice to be at Agnes & Magnus again! Karin was there, & Anna (we were 8 at table) Had salmon again. A perfect meal! A delicious meringue & fruit dessert.

Weache came after dinner too. While we were visiting after dinner - several boats came in - a wonderful view. He has a new boat now - Walter was in it. We took pictures & video and visited. Sat around coffee table & had a marzipan cake (too pretty to cut) & "mor monson" cake (a freshly baked cake with raisins)

All of a sudden it was 7 pm - time went so fast. We drove around town to places Anna said she had never seen before. Walter went up to Arnie's before he went to Syre. They showed him all around their home - guess its quite a place. They want me to see it too. They've been so busy out in their yard getting a barbecue built.

Thurs - got dressed up after breakfast  
- another beautiful sunny day (23<sup>+</sup>)  
Went to the cafe for Komla  
dinner - us 3: Anna & Walter.  
Aslany couldn't come as she was  
alone at the store (J. Con was painting  
the bldg outside). Magnus had  
planned to come but didn't make it.  
The Komla was OK - <sup>they</sup> always use  
some "bygg smel" with theirs, and  
a lamb roll slice, with bits  
of bacon <sup>crisp</sup> & fat poured over. Oh  
yes - large pieces of sausage.  
So it was different.

~~We~~ Before we went to the cafe  
we went to the museum -

Drove to the "Home" - pointed  
up to Tabitha's room - they don't want  
to go in there yet. - It's all very nicely  
furnished, so clean, etc.

Then we went to get some  
groceries for Johanna - can't find  
cleaner here - or shortening for pie.

About 3:30 Walter & I went to Erik's  
again - had coffee, fresh waffles,  
a fancy cake, cookies - & a good  
visit before we went to the Home  
to see Kris & Bertha. Their supper  
had been delayed so we waited  
in the lobby until they finished eating.

✓ went up to their room to visit. They had each a bed, ✓ some easy chairs, lamps, etc. Cozy, but small. They are satisfied to be there - she hasn't been well, ✓ had to be cared for, so he moved in with her. (She said she is 82) She wished she could have served us some food ✓ "stelt for us" - I'm sure she misses those things. Kris showed us some old albums ✓ gave us one of Mom from '58-'59. Walter took some video - but missed getting some things he told about. He has such a good memory for names, dates, and asked about so many people ✓ things. We saw him at a distance after the program at Ake church, but he didn't quite grasp it was Walter who came ✓ spoke to him, ✓ he was whisked away for his ride back home. It bothered him so he couldn't sleep that night wondering who it was who spoke to him, so I'm glad we had a good visit with them. He hugged me many times, ✓ they walked down to the car with us. When he said goodbye again he said "me har Jesus med os, og himlen i vente. Gud velgjerne dere alle!"

Then we drove over to see Tulo & Martha. They were waiting for us. It was easy there too, & hard to get away. Took video & pictures. He played the piano, & had me play. About 2 mos ago he had what ~~they~~ they think must have been a blood clot on the brain. He said he wasn't sick, but couldn't walk, etc. They x-rayed & saw he'd had a small one once before. He looked well & fit. She was good. It was really nice to ~~be with~~ Erik & have him as "guide". It gets late at night so we have to sleep fast.

Fri. Have started getting things ready to pack today - & will have a bath & shampoo after breakfast. Walter came & took Joh & Astrid down town to shop. When they came back my hair was dry & so Walter & I walked downtown - I cashed more tr. checks. We looked at beautiful gold chains at J. Conis - so expensive. They sell more silver right now - but after we left Aslang said an American (who left Norway when 16) came in & bought the heavy gold chain for his wife.

Astrid made cheese omelette, &  
John fried some meat balls for lunch.  
We were invited to Lysa for 5 pm  
dinner - a kind of cod, fried  
with fried onion, butter to pour over,  
boiled potatoes & salad. She had  
just bought a beautiful glass pyrex  
(oval) casserole with silver lid,  
& silver gravy bowl today from  
a gift certificate she got at Xmas  
so used it <sup>today</sup> for the first time. She  
had a fancy ice cream sewing for dessert.  
We were <sup>all</sup> invited to her sister  
Reidun for 7. She lives in a beautiful  
home up the hill beyond Johanna.  
They had lived in US (east coast)  
for 5 yrs (1958 - 1963!) so speaks  
good English. She & her girl friend  
from there had been on a trip  
to Rome, Vienna, Paris, etc  
- leaving from Copenhagen - &  
showed some beautiful pictures.  
I like Reidun (& Aslaug) - R. works  
at a Drug Store downtown, & her  
husband works with the oil.  
He works 2 wks & has 2 wks off, and  
2 weeks & has ~~3~~ <sup>4</sup> wks off - or however.

I packed my big bag, Walter put  
it in the car - his too.

Pat. I got up early, dressed & finished  
packing. I hear the other's packing  
Walter will come for breakfast & will  
leave for "Kaimosi" - hope to get on  
the 9:30 bus for Hanga-roa.  
Had a good trip over the road -  
didn't have to have the car so we  
It wasn't as clean as when we  
went to Skinderson - more boys at  
the house. We drove right "home"  
to Skinderson & unpacked our bags  
(they will return later today from  
gray beard). We drove right to Joe  
& had a lunch there as there was  
lots of time before Smith's flight.  
~~that~~ I went to the washroom as  
Walter wanted a second one for  
after a couple with a little girl  
Ray came & sat at the next table.  
It was the blonde with them  
green children: What a coincidence!  
Walter had phoned Tom after we  
arrived & phone were made to  
meet when we came back from  
Kaimosi, so it was a real surprise  
to meet now. They had just stopped  
by for coffee. We waited until  
Smith's flight came in. Tom came  
out alone - for his flight doesn't

arrive with him so they were trying to trace it.

We drove to ~~the hotel~~ <sup>Skurteveit's</sup> Tasted and showed them around a bit before they went to their hotel. (Garth got a nice red car) We decided to go to Taster Kirke tomorrow (Sun) at 11. Garth was to phone us in the a.m. if he needed clothes etc. He didn't call so we thought they must have been too tired. At 8 a.m. on Sun Walter was just getting up, & heard something outside so looked out the window - just as Garth was pecking in!! How he ever found us without an address or map! He came in & used Walters razor. We all met at Taster Kirke at 11 a.m. - took pictures. What a view! A nice service - baptism + communion. We bought a hymn book there.

Drove around after service & ~~after~~ at a small cafe. (Many are closed - when weather is nice they'd rather be out at the beach)

Walter & I were invited to Petrus' house to visit Per, his wife & fam, Guri Haugen & her daughters Inger & Liv. Showed us around the house - he has made many improvements

He had Skurteveit's address but it was in his suit case!

Mon. we

~~Mon.~~ himself (His wife has her beauty parlor in the basement. I may get my hair done there before we go home.)

They served fresh waffles, cake & pink ice cream. We had a lovely time & were treated royally! It was worth a trip over for that visit. They remembered our folks & Walter. Per even remembered we stopped by in '68 when I met him. (Still raining) We bought flowers & wrote on cards for Bengt & Bô (when we go tonight) & for Luri Haugen. We're also giving flowers & a card to Hendal.  
9:45 pm back home again.

It's been a full day, and very nice too. Natloys have a beautiful home - many oil paintings, flowers & blooming plants indoors, and their large yard is like a park. They have lived there all their married life, (over 50) and have a veg. garden, trees, bushes, flowers, lily pond, and large peis. If it hadn't been raining they said we'd have been out door.

She showed us an album -

It was big, roomy & bright, & furnished nice - white ornaments & ~~two~~ candleholders - pink candles & pink serviettes - etc.

Anita came home & greeted us - a lovely girl of 18 now.

Haldis set the coffee table - pancakes (lapper) & strawberry jam, lefse, cakes (I think they call kringla) and beautiful open-faced sandwiches.

Then she brought in a Can. pie - ga wafel crust, <sup>wh.</sup> Cream filling with cherry preserve filling. Just jummy!

They got along well with the Skurtveits - hadn't met before. Had a good visit.

Just before I got to bottom of stairs I fell! Boy did my left foot hurt! Marie wrapped it when we came home - I couldn't put my weight on it.

They are just off the fjord & have a wonderful view from the window, of boats & sailboats on the water.
