TASTAD — The death of Hannah C. (nee Syhre) age 100 years, of Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, occurred at City Hospital on Thursday, August 18th, 1988. Surviving are her one brother Olaf Syhre of Watertown S.D., three daughters, Evelyn Olson Hundebly, Jennie Ferkingstad and Gudrun Jackson all of Saskatoon; six sons, Peder (Ruth) and Bryon (Martha) of Loreburn, Ed (Mary), Norman (Eunice), George (Alice) and Walter all of Saskatoon; numerous grandchildren, great grandchildren, nieces and nephews. Predeceased by her husband Gustav, a daughter Ruth Elaine, an infant son Harold Charles, her youngest grandchild Robbie Tastad, one brother Hagbert Syhre of Salem, Oregon; three sisters Lisa (Ludvig) Aadland of Loreburn, Lena (O.M.) Akre of Strongfield, Sask. and Lydia (Andrew) Halverson of Sylvan Lake, Alta. and four sons-in-law, Ole Olson, George Hundebly, Tamer Jackson and Jonas Ferkingstad. Mrs. Tastad was born on September 7th, 1887 in Pierpont, S.D. and married Gustav on March 22nd, 1906. They homesteaded in the Hawarden, Sask. district in August 1907. The family moved to the Loreburn district in the early 1920's. In the mid 1950's, Gustav and Hannah retired from the farm to a home in Loreburn. Gustav died on May 24th, 1957. In 1972 Mrs. Tastad moved to Saskatoon where she shared a home with her daughter Gudrun and son Walter. Throughout her life Mrs. Tastad was active in the Lutheran Church. She and Gustav were the first couple married in Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Pierpont, S.D. She was the last surviving charter member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church near Hawarden and was active in Skudesnes Lutheran Church near Loreburn and Zion Lutheran Church in Saskatoon. Under the loving care of Gudrun and Walter, Mrs. Tastad enjoyed a full and active life until her final days. Her house was always full of family, friends, reading, poetry and music.
