Dear Ruth.

Thank you for your letter last spring. You all certainly wonder why you do not hear anything in relation to the form that you signed. It has been rather a complicated matter. There was an austion sale in the summer, and then his house had to be sold, etc. I am now, on behalf of Kjell Hårding, sending you another form to be signed. The background of this is the following rather delicate and sad story.

After unels fillbrand's death it appeared, quite to our surprise, that we had not a new cousin, will by name, beam 1904. Uncle Gullbrand was her father. He one know about ity emept sunt Klars, but she never loss win she was and where she lived. Now, accoring to Swedish law, Gyrli has no right to inherit her father as she is not what we all a "trolovningsbarn" (haddened betrethel whild). This seemed to us rather units so we agreed to give her 10,000 kroner at a gift from the real heirs. (I mist mention that aunt Klara has given up her share to be divided between the over heirs, so there will be 4 main late which will be divided according to the sumber of the resp. family members.
