A new year, Its taking me a long time to mail this letter. We've had some really hot weather since xmas the river flooded on us and we've had quite a time getting every thing salvaged all our pumps got covered with water and they had to be dried out before we could get them going. we have them on rafts now so they can go up and down with the water. Its a little cooler to-day, so maybe our troubles are over. must close now and wish
the same to you
