A Memorial, to be registered of an Indenture made the 1st day of February one thousand eight hundred and sixty two in pursuance of the Act to facilitate the conveyance of Real Property.

Wherein the said party of the First Part in consideration of Five hundred dollars of lawful money of Canada then paid by the said party of the Second Part to the said party of the First Part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, did grant unto the said party of the Second Part, his heirs and assigns, for ever, all and singular the certain parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the Township of Kincardine in the County of Huron and Province of Canada, containing by measurement

Eight Acres of Land by the name of John Johnson being the same as is mentioned in the Third Concession South of the Barham Traverse in the Township

To have and to hold the said above granted premises unto the said party of the Second Part, his heirs and assigns, to and for his and their sole and only use for ever: Which said Indenture is witnessed by John Johnson and William Johnson
