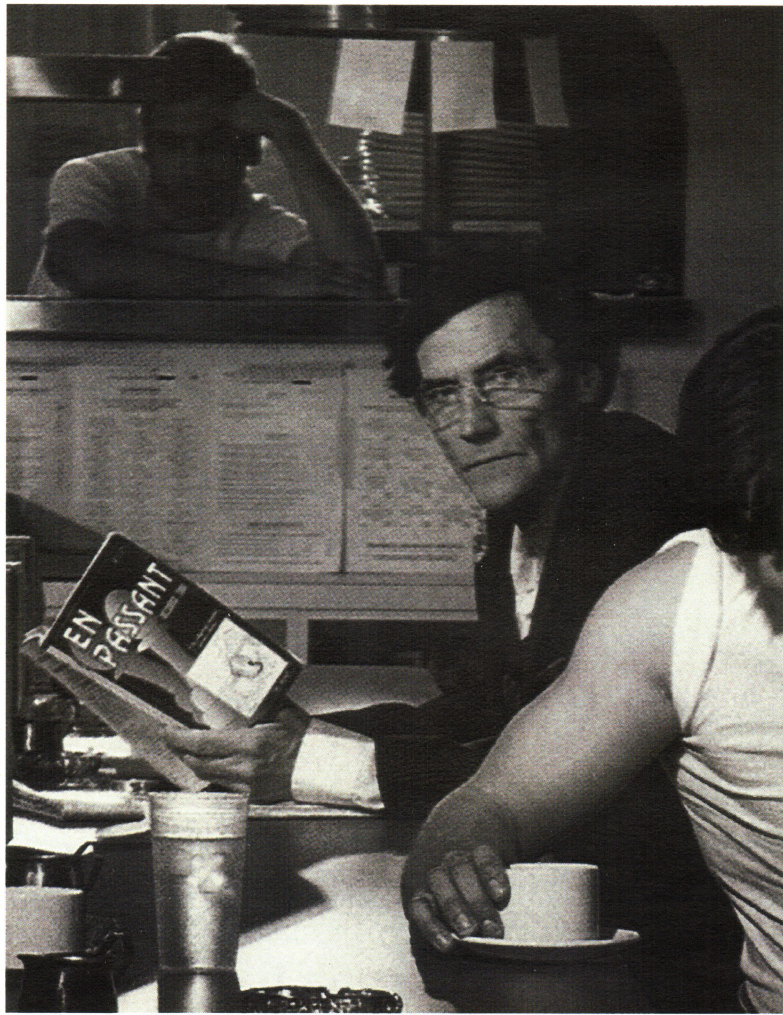


Clarence Eugene Corbin
