The school was much as last year. Teaching supplies are adequate and the library is satisfactory. The flag was flying.

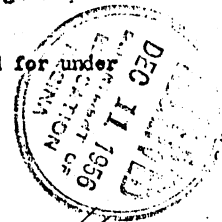
Miss Kempainen impressed me as a conscientious teacher who works hard to give good service.

Work was observed in mathematics, literature, spelling, writing and reading. Lessons were quite satisfactory, pupils were attentive and they responded willingly.

The two Danish children have made good progress since coming to this country. However, care will have to be taken that they are not advanced too rapidly. This was discussed with Miss Kempainen.

As reported previously, the standard of achievement of some of the children is not high. Later in the year we again hope to give some tests in your school.

The daybook was well kept. Good progress can be looked for under the direction of Miss Kempainen.
