The story of my great great grandparents has been a long time in the making but here are all the descendants that I have been able to find to date, to the eighth generation.

Duncan the second child of Archibald(Ardarie) and Nancy (Gore) McKellar, and the oldest son immigrated to Canada with his parents in 1831, where they settled on S½ Lot 5 Con 9 Mosa Twp, Middlesex Co., Ontario. Duncan took up S½ Lot 23 Con 13 Metcalfe Twp. (was Con 7 Ekfrid before 1876), likely when he turned 21. The date of Duncans marriage to Catherine McCallum, is as yet unknown, but believe it to be around 1842/43. Catherine was the daughter of Neil McCallum and Effie Leitch. Both are buried in the Kilmartin Cemetary, north of Glencoe on highway 80. The family consisted of 10 children all likely born on the farm.

My Grandfather Neil married Gertie Little June 27, 1906 at Glencoe, Ontario, daughter of Andrew Little and Sarah Catherine Bunts of Dawn Twp. Lambton Co. This he sold about 1917 and were living on Lot 23 Con 3 when they There were already moved west to Jenner, Alberta. relatives here. They farmed here for 8 years and when Gertie died in 1925, February 9, that fall Neil went to Turner Valley, Alberta to look for land and get some work. He packed up everything and he, Bill and Alex arrived in Okotoks, Alberta December 31, 1925. The next day they loaded up their possessions on a wagon and trailed the cattle to their place at Turner Valley, Section 25, Twp. 19, Range 3, West of the 5th Meridian, which happens to be across the fence south of my house. The price was too high and so eventually They moved north and west 2 miles and lost it. rented until 1935 when Alex and Neil bought S.W. え Sec. 25, Twp. 20, Range 3, W 5th and moved there into a two roomed shack. There were Neil, Alex, Edna and myself, a baby. Alex and Bill continued their education at Lineham School, a one roomed country school. Andy didn't stay at home much after the move to Turner Valley and worked away here and in Ontario. He was killed in a motorcycle accident in Ontario in 1935. Neils daughter Flora did not come here

either as she was married and living at Jenner.
Neil worked at many jobs, on the municipal road
crew with his team, had the cattle pound, worked
building oil derricks, wooden and later steel,
digging mud pits and sumps and putting the machinery
up in the derriks, all with his trusty black team.
We did not own a vehicle so he took the horses and
wagon to work everyday, having to leave early to
be on the job on time.

He loved to talk and was quite a spinner of tall tales, or so we thought. How I wish I had paid more attention to the things he had to tell us about the family, etc. He loved his horses and children, was a trustee of Lineham School Board for a number of years. He called many a square dance at local homes and dance halls. He lived all his life with Alex and family, except for a short while in the Lacombe Nursing Home in Calgary, Alberta. While visiting his daughter Flora he got the Asian Flu and died in the Brooks Hospital. He is buried there and Gertie in the Jenner Cemetery. They had 4 children.

## NEIL M'KELLAR Dies at Glencoe

Ill Short Time, "Grand Old Man" Passes at 86

IN IMPLEMENT BUSINESS

Funeral Services To Be Held This Afternoon

GLENCOE, Nov. 5 — Neil Mc-Kellar, Glencoe's "grand old man", for 58 years in the agricultural implement business here and in many parts of Canada, died yesterday at his home after a brief illness. He was in his 87th year.

Much of his more than a half a century in the implement business he was connected with the Massey-Harris Company. Following 14 years' service in Glencoe he was four years at Ottawa, nine years in Guelph, two years in Chatham, nine in Saskatoon and for the past 20 years in his home town here.

Mr. McKellar was born in Metcalfe Township near Kilmartin, of Scottish parentage. He received his education in the old log schoolhouse at Walkers. From the time he was a small boy he worked on a farm and his interest has since been in farmers and their problems. He started in the implement business in 1882 prior to which he had been at Winnipeg where he was engaged taking freight to Battleford by Red River boat.

Despite his age and an accident three years ago, he was retained as selesman by his company; with the aid of an assistant carrying on his business to the present. He was widely read and conversant with affairs of his time but never entered politics or municipal life.

Surviving are his wife, formerly Miss Helen Munro; one son, Malcolm, in Saskatoon, and a son-inlaw, Dawson McPherson, manager of Massey-Harris in Winnipeg.

The funeral service will be held at his residence, on Monday, at 2 p.m., conducted by Rev. Fred Douglas, of Glencoe Presbyterian Church, assisted by Rev. Dr. Angus A. Graham, of London, a lifetime friend. Interment will be in Kilmartin Cemetery.
