Elizabeth McKellar, wife of the late Malcolm McKellar, died at her late residence, lot 23, concession 9, Caradoc, on Thursday evening, Jan. 18th, after an illness of a few days. She was buried on Saturday following at Poplar Hill, Lobo. The funeral services were conducted by Rev. Colin Sinclair, of the Disciple church, the deceased having been a life-long member of the said denomination. Mrs. McKellar was one of the oldest and most respected of Caradoc's pioneers. She was born in Glassrie, Argyleshire, Scotland, May 5, 1821; emigrated to Canada in 1831; was married to Malcolm McKellar in 1839, in Mosa township, by the Rev. Dugald Sinclair, when they immediately moved to the township of Caradoc where the deceased was a continuous resident until death. Mrs. McKellar was a woman of strong personality. True and honorable, brave in all her undertakings, she was a true type of the noble Scotch emigrant who left their native land to seek new homes in this fair Ontario of ours. She met all obstacles with a firm determination. Her life was one of continuous toil. Having lost her beloved husband in 1851, when he was accidentally killed by the fall of a tree, she had to perform the duties of father as well as those of a mother. She never lost heart, but went ahead with a firm determination. She had hosts of friends in Caradoc and Lobo townships, who loved her for her many noble qualities of heart and hand. Testimony of this was to be found in the large concourse of friends who attended the last sad rites of one whom they had found to love and respect. Mrs. McKellar leaves surviving her five sons and one daughter, viz:—John, of Glencoe; A. B., of Mosa; Alex., of Ekfrid; Malcolm, of Strathburn; Duncan, on the old homestead, and Mrs. D. McKillop, of Aldboro. The following six grandsons of deceased acted as pallbearers:—Malcolm and Duncan McKillop, of Aldboro; Robert W. and Malcolm McKellar, of Mosa; Malcolm McKellar, of Ekfrid; and Malcolm McKellar, of Strathroy.

THE STORY OF THE DAVID ROBERTS BROWN FAMILY.

In the fall of 1850, Mr David Brown and his wife the former Agnes Roberts, with their two young daughters, Agnes and Margaret, left their home in Aberdeen Scotland and travelled to Liverpool England. There on the 31st day of March 1851 their son David Roberts Brown was born. About the middle of May when the child was six weeks old, the family set sail for Canada. After six weeks of storm and some good sailing weather they arrived in the NEW WORLD.

David Brown Sr. was the only member of his family to come to Canada. They travelled to Dorchester township in Elgin County, where Agnes Brown had a brother residing. David had a brother who settled in the United States but was believed killed in the American Civil War.

Mrs Agnes Roberts Brown had two sisters and three brothers who came to Canada, and twin brothers who remained in Scotland. The sisters were Mrs Bryce and Mrs..... The brothers were Henry, David and Andrew. Henry married and had 1 son and 2 daughters. William (Big Bill), Eliza Mrs James Copeman of Tilbury and..... (daughter) who married David Brown (Red Dave) and lived in the Canadian West.

David Roberts married Laurie....., and had three sons William, Gavin and Henry, and 4 daughters, Jane Doan, Agnes Winters, Jessie Brown and Nellie Dawson. David lived on the first Concession of Euphemia Twp. and later in Dawn Twp. Lambton County.

Andrew Roberts married and had 3 sons and 1 daughter. Andrew Jr., May Ellen, Murray and John.

David Brown Sr. and Agnes Roberts Brown had 3 daughters and 1 son (previously mentioned) Agnes, Margaret and David R. and Marion who was born in Canada.

Agnes married John Mitchell and they made their home in Dawn Township. They had six ~~children~~ children. Rene, Archie, David, Jeanette, John and Margaret.

Rene married Tom Switzer who had one son Russel who also had a son.

Jeanette married Frank Monroe and they had one daughter Jean who married Nyles Patterson and they have three children.

Margaret married Garnet Delve of Dresden and they had one daughter Ada who married Goldie Stinson. (I don't know how many children Ada has).

Margaret Brown married Joseph Dennis. They had eight children. Agnes, Mary Margaret, Marion and George (twins) Annie May, Isaac and David.

Agnes married Sam Johnson and they had four children.

Mary married Byron Brown and they had two children.

Marion married Will Harper of Watford (his 2nd wife) She raised his family.

George married Lily Coates and had two daughters Edena and Margaret.

Edena married Elmer McConnell and Margaret married George Winegate. Rockwood, Ontario.

Isaac married.

Annie May married a George Dennis.

David married Elizabeth Slack who died Nov. 1946.

Marion Brown married John Cartwright, One son Will. Married lived near Toronto and had two daughters.

David Roberts Brown's father died when he was about nine years old.

He came to work near Forest as a young man, made his home for some time with Mr and Mrs Norman Kimball. He also spent some winters in the bush in Michigan.

In 1880 he married Mary ann Mc Callum, only daughter of Alex McCallum and Mary (McKellar).

McCallum. They made their home in Dawn Township on thirty sideroad., later moving to the 12th of Dawn 25 sideroad, and also on the townline between Dawn and Euphemia, where he operated a saw mill for several years. About 1909 he purchased the HODGSON Farm Lot 26 Concession 14 Dawn.

Mary Ann Mc callum born July 7, 1861 in Euphemia Township. Daughter of Alex Mc Callum and Mary McKellar. There were three sons and one daughter in this family. John, Mary Ann, ~~Arch~~ Malcom and Archibald.

John married Lucy Smale. They had 7 sons. John of Chatham had one son that they called ~~Rui~~ BUD.

Will married Emma Knight and they lived at Oakdale. They had one daughter Pearl who married Alex Mc Kenzie.

Hector married and lives in Windsor.

Wess in Windsor and ROY in Windsor.

Mac in Chatham married Minnie Brown and had two sons Bruce and Jack. They lived on a farm near Oakdale and later moved to Chatham.

Clifton

Malcom Mc Callum married Elizabeth Styles, they had two sons Gordon and Norman. Gordon had one ~~son~~ ^{DAUGHTER} and Norman ~~one~~ daughter. (Norman died Jan. 1980).

Archibald married Sarah Styles who died quite young leaving a family of six. Katie, May, Wes, Howard, Angus and Eddie. He married a second time and lived in Sarnia until his death in 1942.

Edward C. Matthews was born in Woodhouse Township, Norfolk County April 13th 1877. The oldest son of Charles Matthews and Margaret Kniffen. At the age of six the family moved to a farm in Dawn Twp., Lambton County. In 1900 he came with his family to Brigden, Ontario. In 1904 he married Mary Ellen Brown of Oakdale eldest daughter of Mr and Mrs Roberts Brown. In July 1906 they moved to Lot 4 Con. 3, Moore Twp, which they had purchased from George Young.

The story of my great great grandparents has been a long time in the making but here are all the descendants that I have been able to find to date, to the eighth generation.

Duncan the second child of Archibald(Ardarie) and Nancy (Gore) McKellar, and the oldest son immigrated to Canada with his parents in 1831, where they settled on S½ Lot 5 Con 9 Mosa Twp, Middlesex Co., Ontario. Duncan took up S½ Lot 23 Con 13 Metcalfe Twp. (was Con 7 Ekfrid before 1876), likely when he turned 21. The date of Duncans marriage to Catherine McCallum, is as yet unknown, but believe it to be around 1842/43. Catherine was the daughter of Neil McCallum and Effie Leitch. Both are buried in the Kilmartin Cemetary, north of Glencoe on highway 80. The family consisted of 10 children all likely born on the farm.

He called many a square dance at local homes and dance halls. He lived all his life with Alex and family, except for a short while in the Lacombe Nursing Home in Calgary, Alberta. While visiting his daughter Flora he got the Asian Flu and died in the Brooks Hospital. He is buried there and Gertie in the Jenner Cemetery. They had 4 children.

NEIL M'KELLAR DIES AT GLENCOE

Ill Short Time, "Grand Old Man" Passes at 86

IN IMPLEMENT BUSINESS

Funeral Services To Be Held This Afternoon

GLENCOE, Nov. 5 — Neil McKellar, Glencoe's "grand old man", for 58 years in the agricultural implement business here and in many parts of Canada, died yesterday at his home after a brief illness. He was in his 87th year.

Much of his more than a half a century in the implement business he was connected with the Massey-Harris Company. Following 14 years' service in Glencoe he was four years at Ottawa, nine years in Guelph, two years in Chatham, nine in Saskatoon and for the past 20 years in his home town here.

Mr. McKellar was born in Metcalfe Township near Kilmartin, of Scottish parentage. He received his education in the old log schoolhouse at Walkers. From the time he was a small boy he worked on a farm and his interest has since been in farmers and their problems. He started in the implement business in 1882 prior to which he had been at Winnipeg where he was engaged taking freight to Battleford by Red River boat.

Despite his age and an accident three years ago, he was retained as salesman by his company; with the aid of an assistant carrying on his business to the present. He was widely read and conversant with affairs of his time but never entered politics or municipal life.

Surviving are his wife, formerly Miss Helen Munro; one son, Malcolm, in Saskatoon, and a son-in-law, Dawson McPherson, manager of Massey-Harris in Winnipeg.

The funeral service will be held at his residence, on Monday, at 2 p.m., conducted by Rev. Fred Douglas, of Glencoe Presbyterian Church, assisted by Rev. Dr. Angus A. Graham, of London, a lifetime friend. Interment will be in Kilmartin Cemetery.
