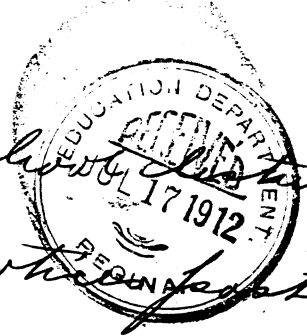

4 corners of sections given out by the department.

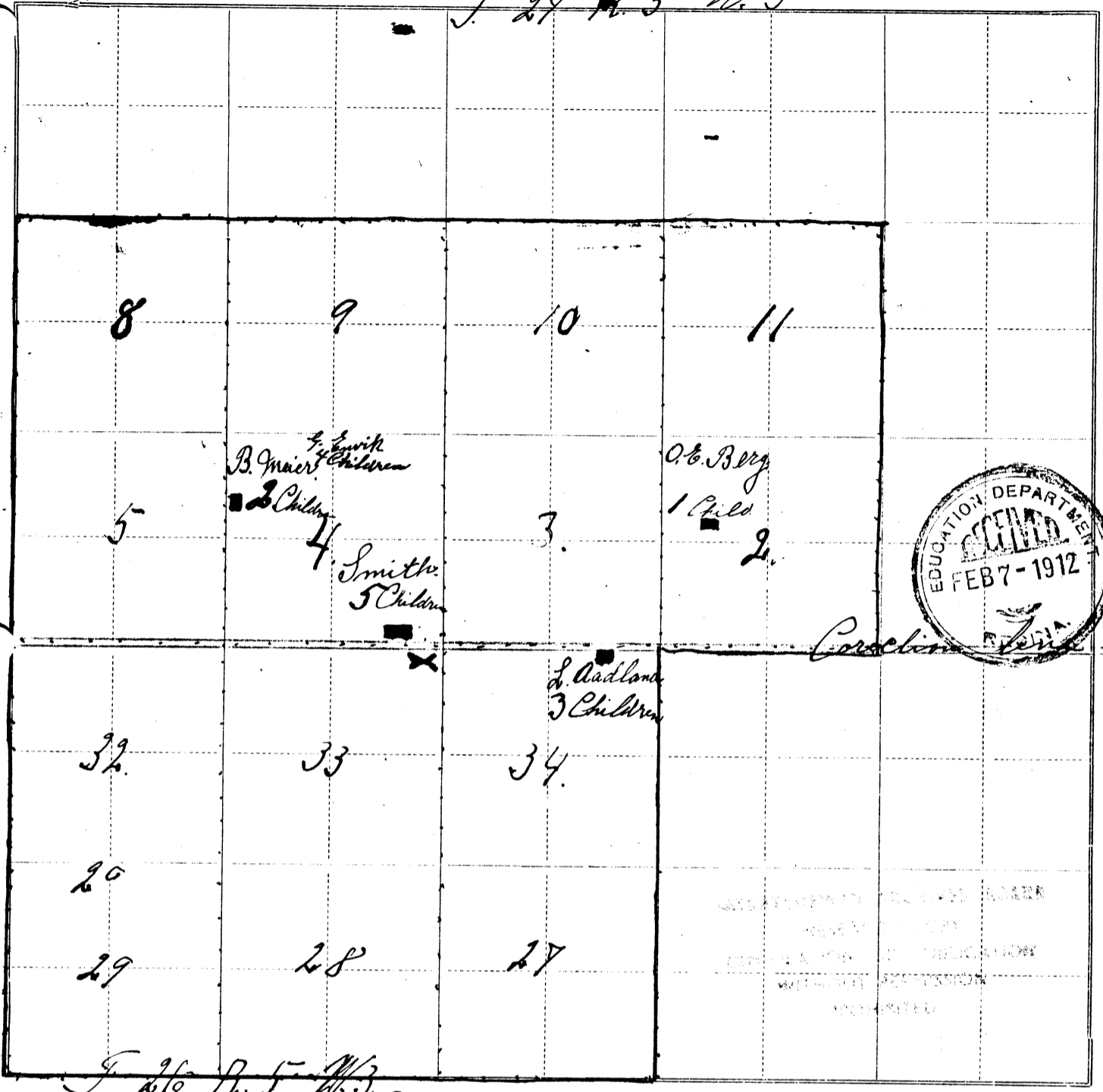
