#### SKUDESNES LUTHERAN CHURCH

The early pioneers came with little in material possessions, but rich in their strong Lutheran faith, long-rooted in the land of their birth, and faith in God and His Holy word. They came too, with faith in this new frontier and in themselves, putting their trust in God, and believing they would flourish in their adopted land.

The early pastors, too, were true pioneers, who ministered to the spiritual needs of His people through all kinds of weather, and travelling (by whatever available means) great distances.

Rev. Ingvald Hustvedt, ordained in 1904, in the Free Church, was the first pastor to serve Skudesnes. He made his home in Hanley, and travelled from there to preaching places as far west as the Broderick district, south to Elbow, and east beyond Craik. His first visit to the Skudesnes area was in 1904. He preached his first sermon at the home of Odin Jacobson in the summer of 1905. This was the begining of many services to follow.

With the arrival of many new settlers in 1906, there was a need for a larger place to meet for worship than what the sod houses and shacks could provide. Besides, there were no shady groves where they could escape the summer sun.

The men decided to build a large bower beside Olaf Berg's house. Green trees and branches were brought fifteen miles from the banks of the Saskatchewan River. Here, Skudesnes held its first official meeting on August 1, 1906.

At the official meeting, Myrtle Christine Aadland was baptized by Pastor Hustvedt. Here too, the first confirmation was held - - that of Hagbert Syhre.

The first members were: Jacob Haugen, Mr. and Mrs. O. M. Akre, Olaf Syhre, Lydia Syhre, Mr. and Mrs. Nils E. Aadland and children.

On December 4, 1906, a committee was appointed — Jacob Haugen, O.M. Akre and Mandius Olson - to draw up a constitution. The constitution was adopted February 13, 1907. The first officers were: Secretary, Mandius Olson; Treasurer, Lars Akre; Trustees, Ludvig Akre, Jacob Haugen and Nils Aadland; Deacons, Mandius Olson, O.M. Akre and Bernhard Meier.

In 1907, the site for the Skudesnes Church was chosen. The congregation called its first pastor and the Rev. W.M. Hagen accepted the call.

The foundation was laid for the Church in 1908, and the following year, the Church was built. The lumber was hauled from Davidson. In 1912, the spire and entrance were added to the church. The basement and chancel were added in 1929. In 1973 an addition was added to the West entry, and in 1978 a Sunday School room was added on the south side and plumbing installed in the basement, which had been renovated.

The constitution was revised on June 7, 1977, and the official name of the Church was to be "Skudesnes Evangelical Lutheran Church."

The ministers who have served at Skudesnes over the years are: Pastor W.M. Hagen, Pastor H.S. Storebo, Pastor J.D. Reitan, Pastor H.S. Quanbeck, Pastor K.J. Gjesfjeld, Pastor Peter Overlid, Pastor S. Rue, Pastor C.O. Ostby, Pastor John Lokken, Pastor Trygve Dahle, Pastor A. Sandness, Pastor Lars Knudson, Pastor J. Hesje, Pastor E. Nord, and Pastor Ken Wilsdon.

Throughout the years, men and women of fortitude have laboured on and we are grateful for the heritage that has been left to us. We pray we may be faithful to that trust.
